The Easter Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday brought many more people, both young and old, to participate in the beauty and richness of the ceremonies. The great Commission given by Jesus Christ "Go out and make disciples of all nations" was fulfilled in the baptisms and confirmations that were Spirit- filled at the Easter Vigil.

New Evangelization challenges us to be missionary disciples who are prepared to make disciples of all nations as we live out our faith in the world.

The Archdiocese of Brisbane is hosting the **Proclaim Event** in July and we will have representatives responding to that Missionary call attending the three day conference at St Laurence's College. Please pray for its success.


