From the Outside of the Window

This Sunday we celebrate the feast of Pentecost. In its original Greek, Pentecost means fifty and refers to the Jewish feast celebrated fifty days after the Passover. It was one of three major feasts during the Jewish year and it celebrated Thanksgiving for harvested crops. For Christians, Pentecost has a different meaning. Pentecost rather is more than just Thanksgiving. The appearance of the Holy Spirit inaugurates a new way of living, a new era of unity. It is for this reason that Christians are called on this Sunday to pray for Christian unity. Perhaps, it is also proper to specially include in our prayers Christians who are suffering persecution.

As you may have noticed, St. James church is a wonderful building with a strong history. It is now more than 100 years old. It is our priority not only to conserve its architecture, but also to maintain its spiritual wealth. This spiritual richness, however, includes you who have chosen this church as your place of worship. It is you who through your prayerful presence contribute to the increase of its spiritual treasure. Hence, the parish will invest in the church's building and in you.

The maintenance of the roof windows is about to be completed, perhaps in a fortnight or so. We still need to paint the plaster circles around the windows, to prevent the incursion of water into the church. The whole project will cost a total of more than 100K. Part of the church's steps has been given a new anti-slippery grip. This work alone costs nearly \$3,500. Thanks to Joe Turrini, Joe Rivera and Fr. Saldie OSA, other steps in front of church will cost nothing, except the material. All worked hard for a hand-shake, a coffee and thanks from God. The savings will go into the new sound system: also includes a loop hearing system. Greg Calvert, who you might know from the past, has already commenced this work. I hope that we will get to enjoy the new modern sound system by next week. Just a note: it costs us around 18K. I have to put more money aside for the renovation of the Priory kitchen that will cater for a broader need of parish functions. New parish toilets will not be cheap either. I guess that this will cost us perhaps another 200 – 250K. I have not calculated yet the cost that will occur with the creation of a crying and playing room in the back for the church. I would like to put in a wall of glass. This will allow parents with young children to follow the mass while they care for their kids, without disrupting the liturgy. I hope that this measure will encourage more young families to join our liturgical celebration.

Beside the renovation of the church building, I am very keen to explore opportunities for the spiritual renewal of our parish. As such, I am thinking of a parish pilgrimage to the Holy Land, or to Italy, that combines holy places with Augustinian hospitality. I have been in the Holy Land several times and lived for nearly nine years in Italy. If you have suggestions, I would love to hear about them.

Another way to enrich your spirituality is the musical "Augustine the Way", that will be performed at Villanova College on June 1st and 2nd starting from 7.00pm. Augustine's life is full of twists and adventures. He was a Saint and a Sinner. I am sure you will love it. The ticket costs \$25. If we show up in great numbers, we might bargain and get a special price. Book tickets - information inside this bulletin. 
