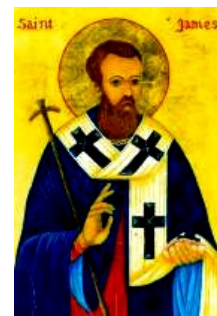

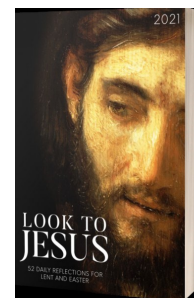


A new and changed Lent and Easter resource for individuals and groups 2021.

Look to Jesus will nourish and nurture prayer each day during Lent and into the first week of Easter.

\$5 book available. Collect from the Sacristy— container for cash: beside books.

The daily reflections (from February 17th) will invite the reader to contemplate a verse from the Scripture reading of the day. This reflection will be followed by a quote from Pope Francis and a simple prayer. The daily reflections will only require a few minutes for a person to read, reflect and pray. This Lenten practice will lead the reader into a deeper reflection on their daily life. As you 'look to Jesus' – in families, workplaces and the community – you will walk as 'missionary disciples' on the path to Easter, and beyond. A small book that is easy to carry, read, while commuting or sitting at home. At the back, there are suggestions for group use and questions for reflection and sharing.
