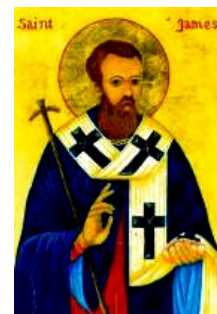

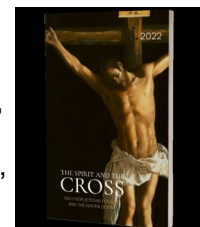

30 Sunday The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults resumes January 30th (9am Mass with dismissal).

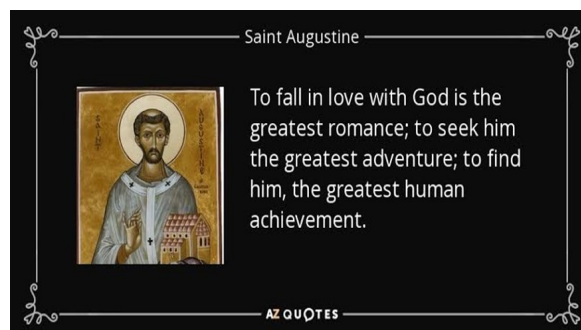


From 11 January, Bishop Ken has let us know Queensland Government directives that will affect capacity limits for Mass and other liturgies. * Masks are mandatory in indoor settings and choir singers and cantors are not exempt. As singing remains a high risk activity, cantors must keep their masks at all times during the liturgy. * Hospitality is also a high risk activity during this peak infection time: hospitality events and gatherings, including those after Masses, suspended and re-evaluated February 2022.
