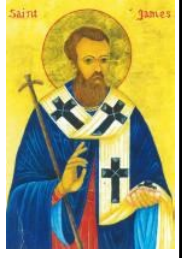

A Commitment to safe communities.



There are several ways in which the Archdiocesan Safeguarding Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy aims to ensure that its parish communities are safe places for all, especially our children and the vulnerable.

Safeguarding Training

All volunteers are required to complete the initial safeguarding training session. You may not have direct contact with children or vulnerable adults, but you may witness something, or have someone disclose to you. As such, these sessions aim to support

parishioners understanding of:

- The context incidents of abuse – Society & Church
- what is harm
- boundaries and boundary violations
- the key element to the Archdiocesan Safeguarding Policy
- how to respond to safeguarding issues in the parish

Ongoing Monitoring – Internal and External Review

- Internal reviews/audits will be conducted annually
- Independent, external review of Parishes over a 5 year period commenced in 2016.
