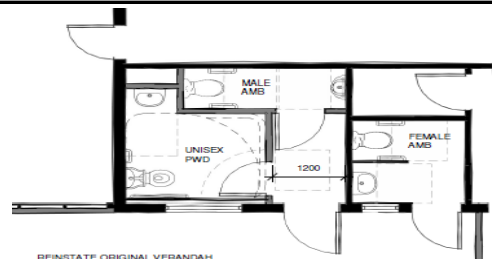

**Congratulations to our parishioner Pat Mullins on his appointment as
Chancellor of the Archdiocese of Brisbane.**

The *Catholic Leader* writes: "Uniquely qualified for the role of chancellor, Mr Mullins is believed to be Australia's only canon lawyer simultaneously practising as a common lawyer. He becomes the first layman to hold the position in Brisbane, succeeding Fr Adrian Farrelly, chancellor for the past 10 years. As chancellor he will be the chief record-keeper within the Brisbane archdiocese, will witness the decrees of Brisbane Archbishop Mark Coleridge under canon

law, and will manage the maintenance of records in the curial offices. Mr Mullins sees challenges ahead in implementing the recommendations of the royal commission into child sexual abuse, and believes in the importance of legally binding protection of religious freedoms."
